# THEMES “Our World after Covid”

## Introduction

This year Pembroke Rotary Club is running its own Youth Competitions. We will be holding 3 remote Competitions, each with the same Theme:

## Young Artist Young Writer Young Photographer

You may enter any or all of the Competitions if you wish. There will only be one round, no physical contact will take place between the entrants and the organisers and the entries will be judged by the Club. There will be cash or voucher prizes for all winners. Every entrant will receive a Certificate of Entry.

## Aims and Objectives

*Our Young Artist competition aims to encourage young people to:*

- be creative
- develop skills in using traditional or contemporary media
- demonstrate interpretation of the topic
- express personal ideas through a selected medium

*Our Young Photographer competition aims to encourage young people to:*

- experiment with photography
- use digital and/or traditional methods of photography
- demonstrate interpretation of the topic
- express ideas through the medium of photography

*Our Young Writer competition aims to encourage young people to:*

- use their writing skills
- write with imagination and creativity

## Who can take part?

Our Competitions are open to all schools and college communities and those who are home educated, along with any other young peoples' community organisations.

There are three age groups:

Junior:	7 to 10 years old
Intermediate:	11 to 13 years old
Senior:	14 to 17 years old

Entrants must not be over the upper age parameter for each group on 31 August 2021. **Competitors must include their age on the application form.**

## Dates

Entrants to any of the Competitions are asked to return their entry and entrance form by **Monday 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2021.**

Judging will take place during June and winners will be notified by the end of August 2021.

## Competition Guidelines

### Competition Tasks

**Young Artist:** to produce one finished 2-dimensional piece of artwork based upon the theme “**Our World after Covid**”. Artwork will not be returned unless specifically requested.

*To accompany the submission each entrant must provide a brief sentence describing the relationship of the artwork to the theme.*

**Young Writer:** to produce a written or typed story in prose entitled “**Our World after Covid**”. The written entry could be fiction or non-fiction, a story or a poem, as long as the piece relates to the theme.

*An A4 page or up to 500 hundred words is a suggested suitable submission.*

**Young Photographer:** to produce a portfolio of three photographs based upon the theme “**Our World after Covid**” in colour or black and white on photographic paper. The prints must be submitted individually. Each print, including any mount should be no larger than A4 size. Mobile phones may be used in addition to cameras.

Photographs will not be returned unless specifically requested.

*To accompany the portfolio, each entrant must provide a brief sentence describing the relationship of each photograph to the theme.*

**Please Note: Photographs which incorporate images of people under 18 years old must be accompanied by written permission from the parent, guardian, or carer.**

### Judges

Persons with appropriate skills, appointed by Pembroke Rotary, will apply the judging criteria below.

### Judging Criteria

Judges will consider technical merit; content and composition; imagination and style.

## Prizes

All entrants will receive a Certificate of Entry. The winners of each Competition will receive a Winners Certificate and a cash or voucher prize.

*Only in exceptional circumstances and at the sole discretion of the Competition organisers, will correspondence or discussion be entered into following the competition.*

**All winning entries will be highlighted on the Pembroke Rotary Club website, Facebook page and local media**

## **Privacy Notice – Youth Competitions**

*[For the purpose of this privacy notice, Rotary International in Great Britain & Ireland (RIBI) also includes Rotary clubs and districts and their members. The use of the term ‘you’, ‘your’ also means that of your child where the competition Entrant is a minor, i.e. under the age of 18 years].*

Members of Rotary International in Great Britain and Ireland (“we”) value the trust you put in us to process your personal information and will always be open and honest about the information we collect and how we will use it. We will never do anything with your personal information that you wouldn’t reasonably expect us to in relation to the Youth Competitions and we will always take every effort to protect your privacy.

The RIBI Privacy Notice is available on our website, [www.rotarygbi.org](http://www.rotarygbi.org), and explains how we collect, process and share personal information. This ‘Privacy Notice – Youth Competitions’ is supplementary to the general RIBI Privacy Notice and explains in more detail how you can expect your personal information to be specifically used in relation to the Youth Competition events.

### **How we use your personal information for Youth Competitions**

1. We are collecting your personal information (and that of your child if a minor) for the organisation and administration of the youth competitions only, it will not be used for any other purpose.
2. Pembroke Rotary Club Public Relations Officers may use your personal information to make contact with you to discuss public relation opportunities and will gain your specific consent at that time for the use of your information, such as photographs/interviews for newspaper articles, club or district websites etc. Where the entrant is a minor only the parent/guardian will be contacted.

### **Providing your personal information to others for Youth Competitions**

3. The personal information will only be shared with others that require it for their role/the services they provide for the organisation and administration of the youth competitions.

### **Retaining and deleting your personal information**

4. All reasonable steps will be taken by those concerned to ensure the personal information they have access to is kept securely and will not be shared with anyone who does not have a legitimate reason to have access to it in relation to the organisation and administration of the competitions.
5. For all the youth competitions, personal information will be kept on file for 3 months after the end date, ie. 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2021. After this date, the information will be securely destroyed (either by shredding, incineration or deletion from electronic devices). This timeframe is necessary to allow for any disputes to be settled before the personal information is destroyed.
